

Networking Instructor

Somerville Community Corporation (SCC) seeks a part-time IT instructor to teach in the Cisco Networking Academy at SCALE. The instructor will be responsible for teaching the Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA) job training program to a cohort of up to 15 adult learners in collaboration with SCC staff. This course is offered in partnership between SCALE and SCC and will be located at SCALE. The CCNA Routing and Switching curriculum is designed for students who are seeking entry-level jobs in information and communication technology. It provides an integrated and comprehensive coverage of networking topics, from fundamentals to advanced applications and services, while providing opportunities for hands-on practical experience and career skills development.

The course is divided into two semesters, each scheduled to run for 35 hours. Part 1 will begin October 2019, and Part 2 will begin in the spring 2020 semester. The course meets twice a week for a total of 4 hours each week. The instructor will be responsible for facilitating class in collaboration with SCC staff, supporting student learning, lesson planning, and student evaluation. This position includes 4 hours of instruction time and approximately 2-4 hours of class prep/planning time each week, and provides a \$3500 stipend.

Requirements:

- CCNA instructor certification from Cisco, or ability to obtain certification prior to course start date
- Experience teaching adult learners from diverse backgrounds, including non-native English speakers
- Availability to attend classes on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 12:30-2:30 October-December (spring schedule TBD)
